South on I-95—Option 1: I-40, I-140, and US 17

If truck traffic is heavy in North Carolina, take I-40 East exit toward Wilmington near milepost 81. See **East on I-40**. This is usually easier driving than continuing on I-95. Traffic is often very high on I-95 from I-40 interchange down into South Carolina.

South on I-95—Option 2: SC 38, US 501, and SC 22

Continue on I-95 into South Carolina past Dillon. Ignore signs to North Myrtle Beach. At milepost 183, take SC 38 East to US 501. After going through Aynor, take SC 22 to North Myrtle Beach. After crossing under SC 31, stay in left lane and take US 17 North. You will see a shopping mall on your left. Ocean Creek is approximately one mile north on the right.

North on I-95—Option 1: I-26, US 17A, and US 17

If truck traffic is especially heavy on I-95, take I-26 East toward Charleston. See **East on I-26**.

North on I-95—Option 2: US 76, US 501, and SC22

If traffic is reasonable on I-95, continue north to Florence and turn right at the I-20 interchange. See **East on I-20**.

East on I-20: US 76, US 501, and SC 22

I-20 ends at I-95. As I-20 crosses I-95, it turns into a bypass around Florence. Continue on US 76 East toward Marion where you take US 501 South. After going through Aynor, take SC 22 to North Myrtle Beach. After crossing under SC 31, stay in left lane and take US 17 North. You will see a shopping mall on your left. Ocean Creek is approximately one mile north on the right.

East on I-26: US 17A, US 17

NOTE: If traffic appears reasonable on I-95, taking I-95 North to I-20 is usually a faster option. Continue East on I-26 past the I-95 interchange toward Charleston. At Summerville, take US 17A North to Georgetown (some of this is 2 lane) and US 17 North toward Myrtle Beach. As you approach Myrtle Beach, take the US 17 Bypass north past Myrtle Beach to North Myrtle Beach. When you go under SC 22, get in the right lane. You will see a shopping mall on your left. Ocean Creek is approximately one mile north on the right.

East on I-40

Take I-40 East until near its end at Wilmington. Take I-140 South toward the Brunswick County Beaches, the Battleship North Carolina, and Myrtle Beach. At the end of I-140, take US 421 and NC 133 South past the battleship and turn right onto US 17 South. In order to skip going through Little River and the upper beach traffic, take Hickman Road between mileposts 3 and 4 (just after Brunswick Plantation). This short section of 2-lane is still faster, because you take SC9 East for a mile and pick up SC31 South to SC 22 (both Interstate quality). Take SC 22 East over the Intracoastal Waterway and keep left. Take US 17 North. You will see a shopping mall on your left. Ocean Creek is approximately one mile north on the right.

East on I-73 or I-74

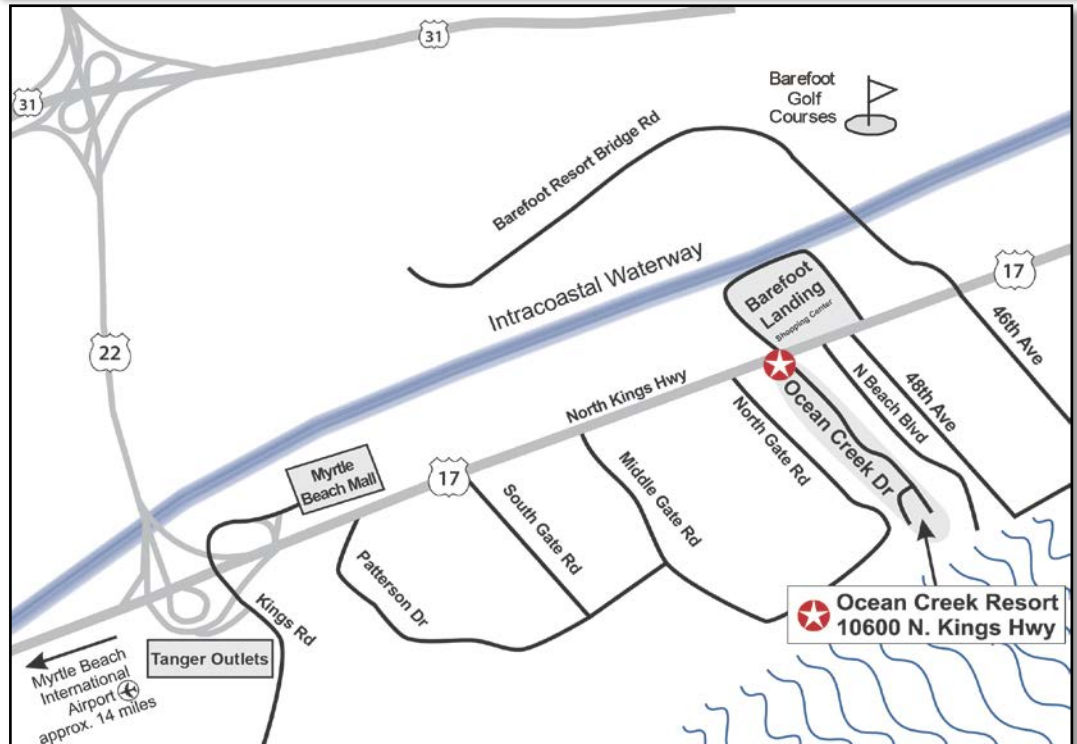
I-73 runs into I-74, which is presently not continuous, but uses US 74 for some of the way. If traffic on I-95 appears reasonable, continue with **South on I-95, Option 2**. If not, continue on I-74/US 74 East until it intersects US 17 south of Wilmington, NC. Continue as per the last half of **East on I-40**.
